- 1. Be at least 12 years old or older
- 2. Have menstrual cycles

## To participate in the study, you must:

- 1. Assent to participate in the study
- 2. Have a parent/legal guardian willing to consent for your study participation
- 3. Share your medical/demographic information
- 4. Answer questions about your gynecological history
- Donate a sample of menstrual flow that can be collected at home using a simple procedure
- 6. Allow ROSE Study researchers to collect excess endometrial tissue samples from a future surgery (if you are undergoing surgery as part of your standard care)

Participants will be compensated for their participation.
