ENDO Talks CZ is the first patient organisation in Czech Republic oriented on endometriosis. The founder and CEO, Misha Lebeda, started the organisation literally from bed in March 2021 shortly after her own endometriosis surgery.

They are focused on spreading awareness about the disease, helping the patients to reach expert care, find reliable information about endometriosis and advocate for the system changes that would make their lives easier.

Some of the few important projects that they have been able to deliver include:

- Support centre the trained volunteers (also endometriosis patients) are helping clients in 1:1 way to orient themselves in the endometriosis, find the necessary expert help and also way how to live with the condition.
- <u>Animated series</u> the goal of the project is to explain to young audience what is endometriosis and what they can do if they are suffering from it. The <u>first part</u> has also English voiceover and was created for Endomarch 2022
- Endomarch 2022 participated in the first organised Endomarch in the Prague.
